Together with staff she has been strengthening our attendance procedures and structures so that parents are supported in getting students to school every day.

As part of this initiative, staff have been issued laptops for the purpose of establishing period-by-period electronic roll marking. This should ensure that we monitor very closely the attendance of all students. Parents are encouraged to contact the school to clarify any concerns about student attendance.

Next week I will be on parental leave. Ms Bowen will relieve as Principal and Ms Jobe will relieve as Deputy Principal.


